Sub:- SE – MC- National Award to Teachers, 2014- Nomination of Union Government nominee on the Selection Committee –Allocation of Awards to State/ Union Territories/ Organizations – Proposals called for –Regarding.

Read:- Govt.Memo.No.20187/S.E.Genl.I/A1/2014.Dt.27.12.2014 along with GOI letter no. F.1-4/2014-NAT, Dt.18.12.2014.Ministry of HRD | Department of School Education and Literacy.

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All the District Educational Officer's in the State are informed that the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi implements a Scheme "National Awards to Teachers" every year. The Government of India have issued certain guidelines for selection of Teachers for National Award, 2014. The GOI have called for the proposals from Government of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2014. The GOI have allotted awards under following categories.

Hence, they are requested to submit the proposals in the prescribed proforma for selection of teachers for National Awards for the year 2014, in duplicate, with due recommendation of District Level Committee indicating at least **Two names of eligible teachers compulsorily** under each category mentioned below:

1. Recognized Primary and Secondary school teachers of State/UT/Organisation.
2. Sanskrit Teachers of Sanskrit Patashalas and Tolls run on traditional lines.
3. Arabic/Persian Teachers of Madarsas run on traditional lines.
4. Teachers of CBSE Schools.
5. Teachers of CISCE affiliated Schools.
6. Teaches of CTSA affiliated Schools and
7. Teachers who promote the education of children with disability in regular schools by states/UTs/Organisations and other school system.

The following guidelines are to be followed for selecting teachers for these awards:

(P.T.O)

I. Certain guidelines for selection of Teachers for National Award, 2014.

1. Classroom teachers with at least 15 years regular teaching experience and Headmasters with 20 years of regular teaching experience and who are actually working as Teachers/Headmasters in recognized Primary / Middle / High / Higher Secondary Schools only shall be considered. Teachers who are teaching upto class VIII should be considered in the category of Primary School Teachers and those teaching Class IX to XII in the category of Secondary School Teachers. For teachers promoting integrated inclusive Education the eligibility will stand reduced from 15 years of classroom teaching experience to 10 years of service and from 20 years to 15 years, if they are to be considered for awards in respect of Inclusive Education.

2. Normally retired teachers are not eligible for the award but those teachers who have served a part of the calendar year (at least for four months i.e., up to 30th April, 2012 in the year to which National Award relates) may be considered, if they fulfill all other conditions. The service rendered on re-employment after attaining the age of superannuation will not count as eligible service.

3. Teachers whose names were recommended last year or before can be considered again, if they are still otherwise eligible and are recommended by the state Govt/ UT.

4. Educational Administrators, Inspectors of Education and the staff of the training colleges are not eligible for these awards.

5. Only those teachers having requisite years of teaching experience, as mentioned at Sl. No. (1) above, as on 31st December of the preceding year of the Award (2012) will be eligible to be considered for the award.

II. Main Considerations that should Guide the Selection of Teachers at Various Levels:

1. Teachers' reputation in the local community;
2. His/Her academic efficiency and desire for its improvement.
3. His/Her genuine interest in and love for children; and
4. His/Her involvement in the social life of the community.

Further it is submitted that the Govt. of India in their letter has constituted District level Committee and State Committee are as follows:

Proposed District Level Committee for all the District Educational Officer's in the State for conduct scrutiny and submit proposals to this office.

The District Educational Officer's in the State may be requested to adhere the following guidelines of GOI while submitting the proposals for National Awards - 2014 duly filled all the columns in the proposals in without leaving any scope for further correspondence, If any of the above particulars are not mentioned clearly, the proposals will be summarily rejected and the citation (Bio-Data and other details) should contain at least 20 lines and invariably be attached to the proposals, the antecedent certificate (the prescribed proforma of antecedent certificate is enclosed) and the service particulars shall invariably be scrutinized and signed by the District Educational Officer.

The proposals should be sent in the name cover of the Commissioner and Director of School Education, A.P, Hyderabad on (or) before 16-01-2015.

The proposals received after 16-01-2015 will not be entertained.

If there is no eligible teacher in their District for this purpose in a particular category, a "Nil" report may also be sent to the C&DSE on (or) before 16-01-2015 without fail.

Further the all the District Educational Officers in the State are should adhere to the following schedule in submission of proposals for National Awards 2014 i.e.

- a. The District Educational Officers shall inform all the concerned through local newspapers for submitting records for National Awards immediately on receipt of the proceedings of C&DSE.
- b. The District Educational Officers shall communicate the proforma and guidelines to the concerned Inspector of police for certification of antecedent.
- c. The last date for receipt of proposals by the District Educational Officers Office is Dt:16-01-2015.
- d. Scrutiny and consolidation of proposals by District Level Committee should be completed by Dt:09-01-2015
- e. Submission of proposals through concerned authorized personnel to the Office of the Commissioner & Director of School Education on (or) before 23-01-2015 along with a Copy of Annexure -II - Part A (including Service Record), Part B, C, D. and Certificate of Antecedent Character and citations issued by GOI.

If any of the above particulars are not mentioned clearly, the proposals will be summarily rejected.

Therefore, they are requested to follow the above orders and submit the proposals as per the dates fixed by this office.

This may be treated as most urgent and top priority should be given to this item of work.
