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The Director of School Education, AP have issued certain instructions in the references cited for school preparedness plan and teaching learning process for the academic year 2021-22 keeping in view of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The SCERT has prepared the worksheet booklets to 1 to 10 classes, based on the previous class (es) learning outcomes of the respective class which will be supplied to Govt sector schools as per UDISE strength particulars.

For effective imparting of teaching learning process in this pandemic the following activities are suggested with time lines.

1	To take up the admissions duly following the COVID protocol	15 <sup>th</sup> July,2021 onwards	Headmaster concerned
2	Conducting baseline test at school (Question paper has to be prepared by class room teacher)	27 <sup>th</sup> to 31 <sup>st</sup> July,2021	HM, teachers (Not exceeding 50 students per day)
3	Evaluation of baseline test	28 <sup>th</sup> July to 3 <sup>rd</sup> August, 2021	Respective Teachers
4	Ensuring that all work books of previous class are practiced (for primary classes only)	2 <sup>nd</sup> to 7 <sup>th</sup> August, 2021	Students, teachers and parents concerned
5	Practicing the current worksheet booklets (for 6th to 10th )	4 <sup>th</sup> to 31 <sup>st</sup> August, 2021	Students, teachers and parents concerned
6	Practicing the current worksheet booklets (for primary classes)	9 <sup>th</sup> to 31 <sup>st</sup> August, 2021	Students, teachers and parents concerned
7	Listening and watching the Radio / TV lessons	As scheduled	Students and teachers

The headmasters of UP Schools and High Schools complete the admissions soon and while admissions they shall convene a meeting of the headmasters of feeder schools in the catchment area and get the record sheets directly from the headmasters and take up admissions with the written consent of the respective parents, so that probable drop out at Class VI and VIII can be arrested.

Headmasters of all schools of all managements are instructed to follow the GORT No:111, Dt:19.04.2021 for promotions during the academic year 2020-21 A review on this item will be done in the month of August with each individual headmaster.

All District Educational Officers are informed that, certain instructions were given in the reference 2nd cited regarding student groups, little teacher, convergence with gram/ward volunteers etc., and requested to adhere those guidelines while administering the above activities.

Under any circumstances class specific lessons prescribed in the syllabus shall not be taught in the current academic year directly without conducting the above activities. Detailed instructions on date from which class room instruction has to be taken up for coverage of syllabus will be issued separately.

In view of the above all the Deputy Educational Officers of Nellore, Kavali, Gudur and Mandal Educational Officers of all Mandals in the district are requested to follow the above guidelines scrupulously and monitor the schools until the regular classes are started in physical for the Academic Year 2021-22.
